

Dear Parents,

Next Week is Safety Week at Pleasant Grove Jr (Jan 14-18). We are excited to focus on safety as a school and learn how to be better prepared for an emergency.

Monday Jan. 14th

- Students will have a lesson in their Advisory Class (9:25-9:45am) to review the Alpine **District Standard Response Protocol (SRP) basics**: Lockout, Lockdown, Evacuation and Shelter Procedures.

Tuesday Jan 15th

- We will practice a **LockOut Drill** during Viking Time (9:40-10:15am).
- During the drill students will not go outside, but inside the building will be our normal Viking Time activities.

Wednesday Jan 16th

- We will practice an **Evacuation Drill** during Viking Time (9:40-10:15am).
- This will involve students evacuating the building with their Viking Time Class (B2 class) and assembling at the track in our back field for a few minutes
- Students will then return to the building to start their B2 Class.
- Remind your student to bring a coat or jacket to Viking Time today.

Thursday Jan. 17th

- We will practice a **LockDown Drill** at some point during the day.
- Students will practice the LockDown protocol in their classroom for a few minutes
- Then when the all clear is sounded the teacher will go back to teaching the lesson as usual, but the class will stay in the locked classroom for the remainder of the LockDown Drill time.

Friday, Jan. 18th

- Students will stay in their Viking Time Class (9:40-10:15am) and have a lesson about the **Safe UT app**.
- This is an app that students can use to anonymously tip the school on student behavior, they can also chat with trained crisis team members and much more.
