

Parent Permission for a student to have an At Home Chromebook

We are looking forward to every student having their own Chromebook this year! **Unfortunately, about half of our students still do not have parent permission to receive a Chromebook.** There are two different permissions that need to be checked in the parent's Skyward account. (1) You must approve the AUP saying your student has permission to use a computer at school. **(2) AND you must also check the permission that says “At Home Chromebook Permission”.** See below for a tutorial.

At Home Chromebook Permission Form

This year a tab for “At Home Chromebook Permission” has been added to the Student Information Update in Skyward for your school. Parents can login to Skyward and give their permission for use of a school chromebook at home on this tab. **If this step is not completed, your student will not receive a chromebook.**
